JobWatch's Employment Documents Interpretation Service (EDIS) provides legal advice and support interpreting any document related to employment or work for all Victorian workers. This includes modern awards, enterprise agreements, employment or other contracts, employer policies and other legal documents.

What is JobWatch?

JobWatch is an employment rights legal centre which provides assistance to disadvantaged and vulnerable Victorian workers regarding their rights at work. We are known for our free, confidential telephone information and referral services for Victorian, Queensland and Tasmanian workers, providing information to between 10-15 thousand callers a year.

How do I access EDIS?

Victorian workers can call JobWatch's Telephone Information Service on **(03) 9662 1933** (Melbourne Metro) or **1800 331 617** (Regional Victoria) and ask for EDIS. You will be asked to email the document to us for review.

Who helps me?

Once you send us the document, a JobWatch lawyer will read and interpret the document. We will meet or call you to provide legal advice.

Employees who have been dismissed have only 21 days to file an unfair dismissal or general protections claim from the date their dismissal took effect - so act quickly and call us now!
